MEMO: For the New Students

We are looking for competent and visionary students to join our College.

1. PROGRAMMES OF ANTS

- 1) Certificate of Attendance in Christian Ministry
- 2) Certificate in Christian Ministry
- 3) Diploma in Bible and theology
- 4) Diploma in Early Childhood Development and Education

2. QUALIFICATIONS as per the regulations of the National Council for Higher Education (NCHE)

1) The applicant for **2 Years Ordinary 'Diploma'**

- a) Must have completed Senior Four (S4, 'O' level UCE) with minimum 5 passes and
- b) Senior Six (S6, 'A' Level UACE) with minimum 1 Principle Pass and 2 Subsidiary Passes obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent.

2) The requirement for **2 Years Ordinary 'Certificate'** is completion of Senior Four (S4, 'O' Level UCE) with at least 3 Passes obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent.

3) **Certificate of Attendance in Christian Ministry** is available for any Pastors who are not qualified for those above.

4) The applicant must be active in some form of local church or Christian ministry.

3. REQUIREMENTS

All applicants need to include the following documents/information when making a full application.

- 1) Registration fee: **50,000/=**.
- 2) Application form – obtainable from ANTS office or from our website: ants.ac
- 3) Testimony of his/her Christian conversion and experiences.
- 4) Three passport-sized photographs to be attached to the application form.
- 5) **Recommendation letters** - this should be made by his/her senior pastor in the church they attend or above and must include how the church will financially support the applicant's study and what is church's future plan about applicant's ministry after graduation.
- 6) Original and photocopies of education (academic) Certificates with Transcripts, which must be equated by **UNEB** (Uganda National Examination Board) or **UBTEB** (Uganda Business and Technical Examination Board) in case of international students. (This equating fee will be deducted from school fees)
- 7) Written Tests of 'Bible Knowledge' and 'English Proficiency' on the day of interview.
- 8) A valid National Identity Card (ID) or Passport.
- 9) All international students must present their **Certificate of Entry or VISA** at the very day of their arrival EACH SEMESTER. If they don't, their enrollment will not be allowed.
- 10) Fill the medical History Form - obtainable from ANTS office. (An health issue that needs attention should be accompanied by a medical recommendation report from a recognized hospital).

UNEB Requirements

- a) Original result slips and transcripts (*of S.3 and A-Level for Rwandese*)
- b) Certified Copies of results slips and transcripts (*Stamped and signed by National Examination Board where they sat*)
(Transcripts that are not in English must be translated first)
- c) Fill a form – obtainable from UNEB office and be signed by the commissioner of oaths.
- d) Fee is 250,000 (UGX) for each document equated.
- e) Two passport-sized photographs.





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f) Appear in person at UNEB for interview.

g) A confirmation letter from the secretary of the examination board from your country to act as prove that you sat for National examination.

UBTEB Requirements

a) Original result slips and transcripts (S.4 or S.3 and S.6 of (WDA) for Rwandese) (Transcripts that are not in English must be translated first)

4. INTERVIEW SCHEDULE

1) Open Interview: during holiday.

2) Registration must be done online (sending document by email) or offline before Interview day. Registration fee **50,000/=** is to be paid with full original documents before Tests.

3) TESTS and INTERVIEW for New Comers: 13th (Thur.) August 2026

Bible Knowledge Test – 9:00 AM

English Proficiency Test – 10:30 AM

Interview – 1:00 PM

4) Orientation: 15th Sat. August 2026

※ CALENDAR for 1st Semester 2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

1. Opening: 17th (Mon.) August 2026

2. Closing: **November 27th** 2026

3. After Admission process is completed, if someone is not reporting back for the following semester, he/she must apply for dead semester/year. In that case, no claim of school fees refund.

※ SCHOOL FEES

1. **Tuition and Accommodation: 990,000/=**

2. **For None Residence students: 600,000/=**

3. **OTHER PAYABLE FEES:** Must be paid in cash on the 1st day of arrival in the office before using any college facilities.

1) Student's welfare fund: **8,000/=** and Student's Cabinet fund: **4,000/=**

2) Contribution of **20,000/=** (**25,000/=** (25,000' = with bank charge) once per year directly to the account held by **NCHE** (National Council for Higher Education). by all students in Diploma and Certificate.

3) Student Identity Card (ID): **10,000/=**

4) Medical fee: **20,000/=**

3. The **whole school fee** should be paid before the 5th week. If not, their enrollment will be cancelled for that semester. In that case, there is no refund of school fees.

4. School will provide any kind of Scholarships and Sponsorships to students only after they pay all their required School Fees including the Other Payable Fees.

5. A special full sponsorship and domestic support per month shall be given to **one (1)** senior pastor (in an intake) recommended by their Bishop, Elders Board, church members of the local church they serve and forwarded by ANTS Alumni. The final verification shall be made by the school administration.

※ ANTS has some special Programs

1. **ESL (English as a Second Language)** is for those who want to learn English as a beginner. It is specifically designed to prepare students for furthering their theological training and public speaking abilities.

1) **Opening:** 17th (Mon.) August 2026

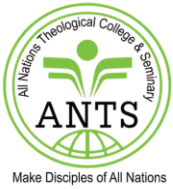
2) **School Fees. 1,621,000 UGX.** Registration, Certificate and every other payable fees included.



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60% must be paid in cash before they start studying at least on arrival in the office of accountant before using any college facilities. Remaining Balance should be paid within one (1) month. If not, their enrollment for the course will be cancelled. In that case, there is no refund of school fees.
